1) Health & Safety

- A reminder to wear appropriate clothes now that it is getting cold.
- A health reminder that l'ÉGC is a NUT FREE school. We have severe lifethreatening allergies in most of our classes.
- Maintenance request sent to Jericho to place drainage around the playground is still a project that the church is intending to do.

Questions for the Executives:

- 1. Will there be a Classroom Budget from the APÉ (i.e 100\$/Teacher)?With receipts, the APÉ agrees on \$100/ teacher and the school will match the amount. Ortho & P.E. teachers will get \$50 and \$50.
- 2. Montréal trip, we need to budget an extra 500\$ for the 2 teachers (250\$/Each). The parents' contribution will pay the extra \$500.

The APÉ's concerns:

- a. The politic debates in D2 and D4 escalate in unkind comments in the class and during recess. When discussing politics, it should be inclusive, respectful and open-minded. - e. Principal will contact Jal Design for model and pricing
- **f.** The garden budget can be used for classes, said Karli. Mme Andréanne already mentioned a class project with D4. Principal will encourage the teachers to contact Karli at the next staff meeting.
