- 3. Principal's Report Marie-Pascale

Dates of trip is Feb 21-28 and for hosting, May 21-28. \$8,000 is the cost for hosting, which includes all the activities.

The cost for going is \$250/student and all the parents paid. There is a balance of \$110. The school will most likely cover that expense.
