APE MINUTES MEETING - September 10th, 2024

3. Principal's Report – Marie-Pascale

Welcome to all parents.

I would like to acknowledge the traditional, ancestral, unceded territory of the Hupacasath and Tseshaht communities and Nuu-Chah-Nulth First Nations, on which we are learning, working and meeting today.

1) Introduce myself & (New) teachers at ÉGC (Mme ève-Lyne (K/1); M. Michael (2/3); Mme Alex(4/5); and Mme Andréanne (6/7). M. Xavier (Francisation & Classe resource/Support/Gr 2 & 3 one day a week). Mr. Sebastian is our PE Teacher for Gr K to 3. I am the English Teacher (Gr 4 to 7). We also have 3 EAs Mme Chantal & Mme Sylvie who is also our Ambassadrice de la culture française, and Mme Maria Laura in the afternoon, who is also our Strong Start/Early Years Educator in the mornings. Mme Annick our Administrative Assistant. PE for gr 4/5 is taught by Mme Alex and Gr 6/7, by Mme Andréanne.

2) ÉGC numbers = 59 students enrolled

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D01= M/1= 10 (4 Kinder & 6 Gr 1)

D02 = Gr 2/3 = 18 (7 Gr 2 & 11 Gr 3)

D03= Gr 4/5 = 17 (11 Gr 4 & 6 Gr 5)

D04= 6/7 = 14 (8 Gr 6 & 6 Gr 7)
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3) Back to School went really well this year.

- K started full-time on Thursday Sept 12.
- Routines are being established and students will gather for their first assembly on the 12th as we will introduce the entire staff and discuss the safety rules inside the school, outside on the playground, at dismissal, and on the bus.
- I am asking all pick-up parents to greet their child safely at the 4-squres and to avoid having them run to you across the parking lot. We also stress the importance of always staying seated on the bus.
- New bus driver for bus #1, Mr. Jason, now knows his way around. Bus #2 is driven by Ms Marlowe. If you wish to arrange playdates, we ask parents to arrange pick-up and notify the office and teachers. There won't be bus rides provided for children who are not signed up for specific buses and stops.
- A reminder when rainy season starts to send your child with a raincoat and rain boots or waterproof boots. We won't allow students in K to Gr 3 to run around without rain pants and boots because of the muddy grass.
- We have also asked every student to bring a change of clothes from K to Gr 7.
