5. Treasurer's report – Angela Harvey

Bank balance as at November 30<sup>th</sup> is \$7.637.72 Gaming account \$2,098.59 Cash on hand - \$154.55 2020 Quebec Trip Funds available -\$6,455.43

Motion to adopt the Treasurer's report as read: M/S/C – Eric/Mario All in favour.

6. Quebec Trip update/ Quebec 2020 – \$9,340 left to pay after \$1000 deposit less \$6455.43 is \$2,885 left to pay breaks down to \$360 per student. Will be a luggage fee as well. Information night January 7<sup>th</sup> at 5pm. Andreanne is a chaperone, as well as her mother (former teacher) and two chaperones from the other school. Plus the organizers chaperones (animators –

- counsellors). Students will do a zoom meeting to get introduced to other students who are going on the Quebec trip.
- 7. Graduation committee June 9<sup>th</sup> is the potential date at 5pm. About 80 people expected. Barclay board room is booked can hold 150 people. Food prices vary depending on choices but will likely be about \$25 for a two entrée meal (for example, lasagna and chicken). Annette Clement is the contact. Kids prices for meals (under nine years old) is half price. The committee can decide closer to the date regarding meal choices. Room layout will be drawn out prior to event for approval. We can bring our own music or use the satellite radio station. They will provide a mic and podium. We could bring in speakers if we wanted music for dancing. Slide show done last year photos submitted by parents and compiled by Principal and Secretary.
- 8. APE funding for sidewalk from park to cement drainage issue ice freezes and makes mud. Ice could be on cement and be a hazard. Madame Pascale will talk to experts to see what can be done.
- 9. Student led conferences amalgamation with parent teacher interviews all in favour of that. Avoid having to come back twice. This year, will have a dance recital. Will have singing. Will have classes working together. Will film it.

Will decorate as much as they can. Will be a potluck. Need numbers attending. December 17<sup>th</sup> at 10:30 until about 1pm. Will book the gym now for next year. Will try to book a date earlier in December.

- 12. Movie nights all booked with the church.
